

Belgo-Lux Association of Cricket Umpires

Constitution

1. The Belgo-Lux Association of Cricket Umpires (BLACU) shall be a semi-independent body attached to the Belgian Cricket Federation. It shall also maintain close links with the Luxembourg Cricket Federation.
2. Its objective shall be to further the cause of cricket in Belgium and Luxembourg by training umpires and providing umpires for BCF league and cup matches, international matches and any other matches when asked to do so.
3. All persons who have passed the BCF umpiring examination shall automatically become members. Any other person with an appropriate umpiring qualification shall also be eligible for membership.
4. The BLACU shall be administered by a Secretary, assisted by an Assistant Secretary, who shall be elected by a simple majority vote of the members present at the AGM, which shall take place before the start of every BCF league season, or as soon as possible thereafter.
5. Administrative costs relating to the provision of umpires for matches under the responsibility of the BCF shall be met by the BCF. Match umpires' expenses shall be paid by the clubs concerned and/or the BCF as decided by the BCF and laid down in the league rules.
6. Any other costs which the BLACU requires to be met by the BCF or LCF shall be subject to prior authorisation by the body concerned.
7. The BLACU shall not levy subscriptions from its members in the first instance, without prejudice to this being reviewed at a later stage.
8. Amendments to this Constitution may be made by a simple majority vote of the members present at the AGM.
